# **SESSION TIMES**





## **PURPOSE**

This policy outlines the Pre-school sessions times for both the three-year-old program and the four-year-old program at Woodridge Pre-school.



## **POLICY STATEMENT**

## **VALUES**

The timetables reflect Woodridge's Pre-School commitment to Universal Access in providing 15 hours of early childhood education in the four-year-old program.

## **SCOPE**

This policy applies to the approved provider, persons with management or control, nominated supervisor, persons in day-to-day charge, early childhood teachers, educators, other staff, students, volunteers, parents/guardians, children and others attending the programs and activities of Woodridge Pre-school, including during offsite excursions and activities.

Universal Access - Universal access is a commitment made by the Council of Australian Governments (COAG) that by 2013 every child will have access to a preschool program in the 12 months prior to full time schooling. This program is to run 15 hours a week.
